
SNAP SHOTS OF THE RURAL BLESSING MISSION

I invite you as reader to see all through my eyes...








IMPRESSIONS OF ANJI - RBM, HEADQUARTER'

I took the chance to see a small city (or big village) and walked around. John – a very nice boy from the home – joined me that I'm not getting lost and that he could communicate to the local people :o).







HOSPITAL IN ANJI




Public hospital in Anji – in the mid of the big picture is the entrance you can see on the right side of the slide.
